How to log in and place a hold on a book

- 1. Click the link to go to the Destiny Discover page.

- 2. Click the log in button on the upper right corner of the screen.



3. Sign in to your account by using your student account number for the username and the password. The username and the password is the same number. Then hit the blue "Submit" button.

4. Type a title, author, series, or subject into the search box on the top of the page to look for a book. Click the magnifying glass or press the enter key on your keyboard to submit the search.
